



## Vocational Scholarship

Graduating High School Senior or GED

The **Northern Arizona Loggers Association** may award scholarship(s) in an amount \$1500.00 to assist a student(s) in pursuing a higher education. This scholarship(s) will be awarded for the fall semester and applications must be received COB July 1<sup>st</sup>. In addition, the applicant will be notified of any interview that the scholarship committee may desire before they make their final decision. The application must be made on an original form-no faxes or photocopies.

- Eligibility
  - The applicant must be related to an association member, or related to an individual who is employed by an association member. *The association member must be in good standing at the time of the application.*
  - The individual must graduate from high school or have completed a GED and be accepted for vocational/technical coursework by a vocational institution.
    - Attach a copy of your registration for the fall semester.
      - *We realize that this is not always available in time for the application, if that is the case please include that information with your application.*
  - A copy of your high school diploma or GED equivalent.
  - Sealed recommendation letters (3) on the form provided by NALA must be received by scholarship deadline (teachers/employers/church leaders not related to you or your family).
  - Attach a **250 word** essay discussing your education goals.
  - A current portrait type **photograph** at 5x7".
  - Primary consideration will be given to:
    - Arizona high school graduates
    - Applicants directly related to member principles [sons/daughters]
    - Graduates attending Arizona universities/colleges/trade schools
    - Applicants with a proposed forestry major
