

## **Vocational Scholarship**

Graduating High School Senior or GED

The Northern Arizona Loggers Association may award scholarship(s) in an amount \$1500.00 to assist a student(s) in pursuing a higher education. This scholarship(s) will be awarded for the fall semester and applications must be received COB July 1st. In addition, the applicant will be notified of any interview that the scholarship committee may desire before they make their final decision. The application must be made on an original form-no faxes or photocopies.

•	Eligibility
	The applicant must be related to an association member, or related to an individual who is employed by an association member. <i>The association member must be in good standing at the time of the application.</i>
	The individual must graduate from high school or have completed a GED and be accepted for vocational/technical cousework by a vocational institution.  O Attach a copy of your registration for the fall semester.  We realize that this is not always available in time for the application, if that is the case please include that information with your application.
	A copy of your high school diploma or GED equivalent.
	Sealed recommendation letters (3) on the form provided by NALA must be received by scholarship deadline (teachers/employers/church leaders <u>not related to you</u> or your family).

☐ Attach a **250 word** essay discussing your education goals.

  - o Arizona high school graduates
  - Applicants directly related to member principles [sons/daughters]
  - Graduates attending Arizona universities/colleges/trade schools
  - Applicants with a proposed forestry major
